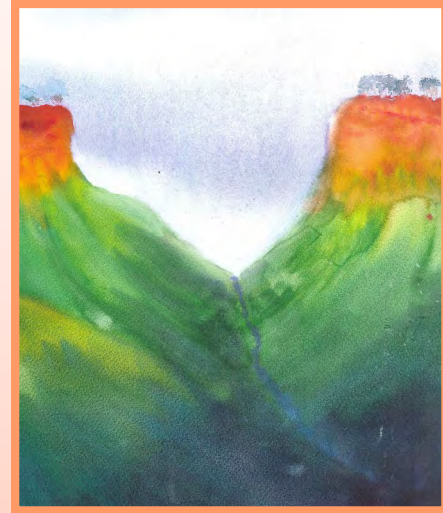


Enhancing the Teaching of Literacy through Imagination
