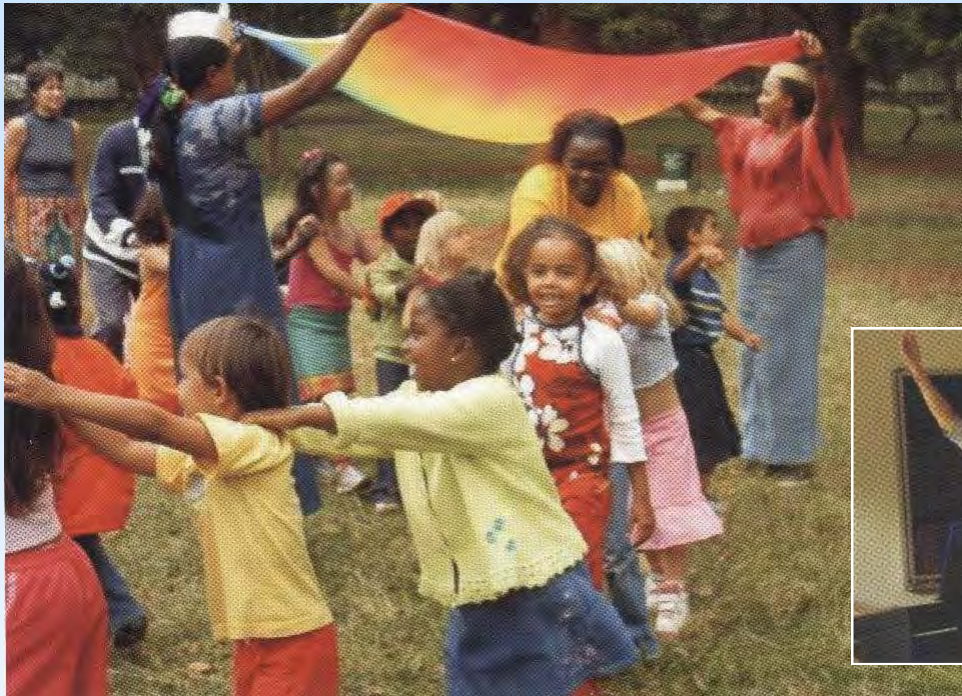


‘Creative Thinking develops from Healthy Movement’
